## Message Summary

In week 2 of The Big Oh!, Eugene showed us another shocking part of God's plan for our lives, and it's this week's Big Idea: **give God your best**. How that plays out in our lives can be broken down into the following 3 questions:

- 1. **How can we give God our best?** Eugene pointed out that we can honor God with our best on the job, in our marriages, by being faithful, in our tithes and offerings, by giving each other our best and also by giving God our bests by how we use the gifts and talents he's given to us.
- 2. **How does God giving us his best help us?** God gave us his best when we sent Jesus to pay for our sins on the cross. Some of the benefits that we gain from that gift are salvation, eternal life, having our names written in the book of life and receiving new life by being born again!
- 3. How does giving our best to God help us? Let's face it, most of us want to know what the payoff is if we do something, and the great news is that when we give our best to God, we gain quite a bit in the process. We are anointed, we gain the ability to hear God, we receive power and spiritual strength, greater peace, joy and faith, and we find a new capacity to have love from God and to give love to others.
